

#### Mobility in France (MESRI)<sup>(2)</sup>

In 2016-2017, France hosted 644 students from Pakistan, 35% of whom are women. 409 (63.5%) registered at universities, 57 (8%) at Business Schools, 51 (8%) at Engineering Schools and 127 (20%) at other schools (*Grandes Ecoles*, Art Schools, Specialized Schools...).
